Course Description: The study and application of basic acting theories and principles for the beginning actor. THTR 153 and COMM 257 are cross-listed courses – only one of these designated courses will be accepted for credit. Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. create a character for the stage;
- B. identify and incorporate basic acting theories into character preparation and performance;
- C. observe and analyze behavior of self and others for character preparation; and
- D. audition in a professionally prepared format.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will (The letter designations at the end of each statement refer to the learning outcome(s).)

- 1. prepare and perform specifically designed characters in at least two (2) monologue and one (2) duo or trio scene presentations. (A,B,C,D)
- 2. demonstrate usage of fundamental acting theories through examination and through incorporation into class acting presentations. (A,B,C,D)
- 3. keep a daily character sketch journal of observations of behaviors of self, others, and animals. (C,D)
- 4. prepare a professionally formatted acting audition for class. (A,B,C,D)

Course Requirements: This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
