Course Title: Techniques of the Masters

Course Prerequisites: None

Textbook: Marien, Mary Warner. *Photography: A Cultural History*.
4th Edition.

Course Description: This course will introduce influential photographers to the student. The purpose is to identify the qualities and techniques of the masters so that students may become inspired to photograph under their influence.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. identify the techniques and impact of various photographic masters;
- B. apply the techniques of each master to their personal photographic images; and
- C. find inspiration in the works of other artists to use in his or her work.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. produce five photographs showing an understanding of each master's technique as translated through five photography projects. (A,B)
- 2. give an oral presentation to the class on an additional artist in whom the student has found inspiration. (A,C)
