Course Title: Print Reading for Engineering and Manufacturing

Course Prerequisite: Math 098

Textbook(s): Print Reading for Industry 11th edition, Brown/Brown, Goodheart-Willcox, ISBN: 978-1-64564-672-3

Course Description: A course for industrial trade apprentices and drafters who need expertise in interpreting industrial blueprints, the 'graphic language' of industry. Emphasis is placed on blueprints as related to an industrial setting, symbolism, terminology, notes, material specifications and requirements, and sketching.

- A. describe various types of industrial blueprints and their purpose;
- B. identify and interpret line types, abbreviations, symbols, and information found on different types of prints;
- C. identify various dimensioning methods; and
- D. interpret and calculate dimensions.

- 5. interpret and calculate dimensions. (B)
