Course Title: Robotic Control Systems

Course Prerequisites: TEED 101

Textbook(s): Online eLearning - Amatrol LMS

Course Description: This course is an introduction course in industrial robotics, which includes programming and operation. Programming with software, as well as pendant will be used. Through the curriculum and hands-on experience gained in working with the robot in lab, students learn to create automated work cells.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the course, the student will:

- A. identify the major hardware components of an industrial robot;
- B. create a new workspace and work cell;
- C. testing the program in the simulation mode;
- D. editing program, using teach pendant; and
- E. execute industrial application labs.
