Course Title: Live Video Productions

Course Prerequisites: None

Textbook: Shyles, Leonard. The Art of Video Production. 2007 Edition.

Course Description: This course explores the various aspects of live video productions such as: effective use of video equipment, lighting, continuity, audio production, storyboarding, and field shooting.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course the student will

- A. use studio production equipment including studio cameras with tripods and dollies, lighting, sound board, and microphones;
- B. produce a 30-minute *This is BPCC* live in the television studio, utilizing a script, the teleprompter, music, and graphics; and
- C. label the parts of the studio camera, tripod, and dolly, and identify movements performed in the TV studio by a camera operator.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. learn to distinguish between a basic television system and an expanded television system. (A)
- 2. identify the parts of a studio and studio camera. (C)
- 3. unlock the camera, set up shots, calibrate focus, and use the headsets. (A, C)
- 4. identify correctly the components of the studio control room. (A, C)
- 5. view live productions and look-live productions. (B)
- 6. label scripts for technical director, CG operator, and camera operators. (B)
- 7. follow instructions from the technical director on camera movements. (A)
- 8. identify audio and video connectors. (C)
- 9. write script and mark for teleprompter, CG, audio, and video. (B)

Course Requirements: This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
