Course Title: Sound Design for Film and Video

Midi, SMPTE, sync, Foley, sound effects recording, ADR, looping, and music for video will all be covered.

- 7. demonstrate advanced editing. (D)
- 8. insert and synchronize sound and music files into film/video production. (D)
