Course Title: Mobile Application Development

Course Description: This course covers the basics of developing applications for mobile devices. By the end of this course, students will be able to design, code, test and debug mobile applications.

- A. Write code that runs on mobile devices
- B. Display graphics and interactive elements via a mobile app
- C. Build mobile applications that respond to user input
- D. Build mobile applications that integrate with external data sources

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will or will be able to:

- 1. Create software projects that target mobile devices (A)
- 2. Write in a coding language used on mobile devices (such as Kotlin, Swift, Dart, C# or Javascript) (A)
- 3. Write code to display graphics on a mobile device screen (B)
- 4. Write code to display buttons and text fields on a mobile device screen (B)
- 5. Write code that responds to user input (B, C)
- 6. Build projects that store data directly on a mobile device (D)
- 7. Build projects that read from data stored on a mobile device (D)
- 8. Build projects that read data from a REST API (D)

Course Requirements:

- 1. Achieve a course average of 70% or above.

- 3. Students must have access to Windows <u>and</u> Mac computers and the Internet to complete the assignments.
