- D. verbalize art vocabulary in their own work and within group critiques; and
- E. have experienced advanced drawing problems involving the figure and/or portrait drawing.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. create a series of drawing from subject matter the student chooses (A).
- 2. utilize advanced drawing media (B).
- 3. work independently on creating drawing compositions (C and E).
- 4. create an elongated drawing problem utilizing color media (B and C).
- 5. participate in individual and groups utilizing art vocabulary (D).

Course Requirements: Students are required to complete weekly homework assignments and graded classroom assignments per unit of study. A sketchbook of assignments is also required.
