**Course Title:** Art History II

**Course Description:** A continuation of Art History I. A survey course of the development of the visual arts and civilizations from the Renaissance to contemporary art. The Louisiana Statewide Common Course Catalog name and number for this course are CART 2113: Art History II.

**Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of the course, the student will

- A. recognize important works of art and their role in the development of civilization;
- B. distinguish the evolution and development of artworks, including paintings, sculpture, and major architecture in different civilizations; and
- C. identify vocabulary appropriate to artworks in each period of study.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. analyze European and American art works that suggest the development of civilizations from the Renaissance era to the 21st century (A, B, and C).
- 2. demonstrate a comprehension of the evolution of art and its development through the time periods of the Renaissance to the 21st century (B and C).
- 3. identify vocabulary appropriate to works of art per period of study (C).
