Course Requirements: Students will review present tense and write two papers about it; learn

the future and the conditional and write two papers about it; translate a short story showing the use of all other past tenses. Interactive practices, quizzes, and practice translations are required. Students will be evaluated once orally in an interview of five and ten minutes in the

middle of the semester. Tests will be given in addition to a

comprehensive final.
