Course Title: Concert Band

Course Description: A diverse variety of band repertoire will be rehearsed and performed each term. Works to be studied will include, but not be limited to, orchestral transcriptions, original band and wind ensemble works, solos with band accompaniment, and section features. Instruction will also include coaching toward proper ensemble/individual performance techniques, sight reading, and rhythmic reading skills. Open to all students who have high school experience playing a traditional band instrument. (May be repeated for credit)

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. perform appropriate concert band repertoire in a variety of style periods with correct notes, rhythms, and expression;
- B. successfully sight-read appropriate concert band repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, and expression;
- C. read and perform music at a higher level of proficiency than when they began the course; and
- D. be familiar with a variety of composers for the concert band and wind ensemble medium.

- 1. perform a variety of appropriate concert band repertoire with correct notes, rhythms, and expression through rehearsal and concert performance. (A)

- 3. develop their music reading and music performance skills to a higher degree of proficiency than when they began the course through distributed rehearsal, practice, and performance. (A,B,C)
- 4. become familiar with a variety of composers for the concert band and wind ensemble medium through rehearsal and performance (A,B,C,D)
