Course Description: A diverse variety of choir repertoire will be rehearsed and performed each term. Instruction will also include coaching toward proper ensemble/individual performance techniques, sight reading, and rhythmic reading skills. Open to all students. (May be repeated for credit.)

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. perform appropriate concert choir repertoire in a variety of style periods with correct notes, rhythms, and expression;
- B. successfully sight-read appropriate concert choir repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, and expression; and
- C. read and perform music at a higher level of proficiency than when they began the course.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. perform a variety of appropriate concert choir repertoire with correct notes, rhythms, and expression through rehearsal and concert performance. (A)
- 2. develop their sight-reading skills using correct notes, rhythms, and expression through practice and performance application. (B)
- 3. develop their music reading and music performance skills to a higher degree of proficiency than when they began the course through distributed rehearsal, practice, and performance. (A,B,C)
- 4. recognize a variety of composers for the concert choir medium through rehearsal and performance. (A,B,C)

Course Requirements: This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
