**Course Title:** World Civilization II

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Textbook(s):** No Textbook

**Course Description:** A survey of major world civilizations from 1500 to the present, including their interactions and influences on each other. The Louisiana Statewide Common Course Catalog name and number for this course are CHIS 1123: World Civilization II.

**Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of the course, the student will:

- A. demonstrate an understanding of Colonialism, revolutions, Imperialism, and Globalization;
- B. analyze important ideological movements in the modern World;
- C. evaluate the changes in the balance of power at various times throughout the modern World;
- D. evaluate causes and outcomes of major wars throughout the modern World.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will:

- 1. summarize the importance of Colonialism, Imperialism, and Communism; (A, B)
- 2. evaluate the importance of the Industrial Revolution; (A)
- 3. summarize the importance of the Scientific Revolution; (A)
- 4. identify the leaders and explain the importance of the Protestant Reformation; (B)
- 5. critique the importance of the various leaders in Europe, Asia, Africa, Middle East, Russia, Latin America, etc.; (C)
- 6. list causes and outcomes of the Thirty Years' War, the Wars of Spanish Succession, the Atlantic Revolutions, the Opium Wars, World War I, World War II, and the Cold War. (C, D)

**Course Requirements:** Student attendance is expected in accordance with the BPCC Student Handbook. Class material is primarily lecture, but students are expected to read the text for complete understanding. Students will be evaluated on results of exams and other assessments assigned by the instructor. Students are required to participate in classroom discussions and activities.
