Course Title: Audio Production in Media

Course Prerequisites: COMM 120

Course Description: This course will provide the student with a broad introduction to audio principles and operation. Topics included are: acoustics, system wiring, and various types of analog and digital equipment. MUSC 226 and COMM 225 are cross-listed courses — only one of these designated courses will be accepted for credit.

- A. demonstrate a general knowledge of audio principles; and
- B. demonstrate set-up and operation of simple audio systems for sound reinforcement and broadcast.

- 1. know the basic communications model and how it relates to audio equipment microphones, mixers, electronics, amplifiers, speakers. (A)
- 2. have an introduction to analog and digital recording. (A)

- 4. have a basic understanding of acoustics and how acoustics affect various rooms and their uses. (A, B)
- 5. utilize the right microphone for a given application. (A, B)
