**Course Prefix and Number:** ART 103 **Credit hours:** 3

**Course Title:** Drawing I

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Textbook(s):** Rockman, *Drawing Essentials*

**Course Description:** An introduction to fundamentals of basic drawing. Emphasis on skills, composition, and varied materials.

**Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of this course, the student will be able to

- A. apply basic concepts of line, volume, space, and value on a two-dimensional surface;
- B. work on basic drawing problems with organic shapes and geometric shapes;
- C. research old masters and contemporary artists for reproduction purposes;
- D. incorporate art vocabulary in their own works and within group critiques; and
- E. work with varied drawing media, including graphite, charcoal, and ink.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. complete assignments stressing basic drawing skills (A and B).
- 2. view old master works and contemporary artists with accompanying lectures (C ).
- 3. experience drawing with graphite, charcoal, and ink (E).
- 4. participate in group critiques stressing art vocabulary (D).

**Course Requirements:** Students are required to complete weekly homework assignments and graded classroom assignments per unit of study. A sketchbook of assignments including three off-campus sites is required.
