- D. perform simple standard beginning guitar/electric bass repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, chords, fingerings, and instrument technique.

- 1. recall the pitches on the instrument and perform basic major scale patterns using correct finger and hand positions through lecture, demonstration, and practice application. (A)
- 2. perform basic I, IV, V(7) chords in the keys of C, G, and D through lecture, demonstration, and practice application. (B)
- 3. demonstrate basic music reading skills through lecture, demonstration, and practice application. (A,B,C)
- 4. perform simple standard beginning guitar/electric bass repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, chords, fingerings, and instrument technique. (A,B,C,D)

Course Requirements: This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
