Course Title: Audio Production in Media

**Course Description:** This course will provide the student with a broad introduction to audio principles and operation. Topics included are: acoustics, system wiring, and various types of analog and digital equipment.

- 4. have a basic understanding of acoustics and how acoustics affect various rooms and their uses. (A, B)
- 5. utilize the right microphone for a given application. (A, B)
