Course Description: Advanced topics in Linux, including the Linux file system, directories, utilities, the shell and command line operations, the kernel, server software, and applications of Linux to network security.

- 6. discuss aspects of security, including firewalls and mail servers (C); and
- 7. utilize knowledge of Linux to implement network security (A,B,C).
