Course Description: An introductory course in pottery making, including the

study and application of basic hand-building methods, firing, glazing, and an introduction to wheel throwing

ceramic ware.

- B. develop at least one work that combines two or more basic ceramic hand-building techniques;
- C. develop design concepts for individuals works while demonstrating an ability to carry these designs through to completion;
- D. apply glazes for surface development on finished works; and
- E. build and utilize an art vocabulary appropriate to the environment of a ceramic studio.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. produce ceramic vessels utilizing basic hand-building techniques in a timely manner (A and B)
- 2. demonstrate a progression conceptualizing designs, developing structurally sound forms, and finishing surfaces for a completed ceramic work (C and D).
- 3. learn vocabulary related to basic ceramics including formal elements, building techniques, and glazing processes (E).
- 4. participate in wheel throwing ceramic ware as part of design concept for an object (C).

and finished works by the individual.
