Course Description: Adobe Photoshop is explored as a pixel-based editing program. Photographs and graphics are enhanced, altered, and combined to generate new compositions.

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. create and manipulate multi-layered compositions;
- B. modify and retouch existing imagery;
- C. generate and stylize text; and
- D. use various drawing tools to generate imagery.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. create unique composites using all available layer types and attributes. (A)
- 2. use selection tools and masks to isolate and alter parts of images. (A, B)
- 3. use various tools and techniques to retouch and modify photography. (B)

- 5. use multiple drawing tools to create digitally painted works and to modify existing images. (D)
