Course Description: Students will study those features of Photoshop that are most intimidating, such as channels, masking, and file management. Careful attention will be given to coping with image problems and restoring old or damaged photographs.

- C. correct image problems;
- D. utilize advanced retouching and restoration methods; and
- E. apply special effect techniques.

2. save and arrange digital negatives effectively. (A)

5. remove braces from teeth, correct teeth stains, and improve eye issues. (C,D)
6. restore old photos. (D)
7. create dramatic lighting; work with special borders, vignettes, and gradients; and convert color images to black and white. (E)
