Course Title: Pro Tools II

Course Description: This course develops an understanding of the techniques and technology involved in modern multi-track recording and mixing. Hands-on projects include: recording techniques for music, speech and sound effects; operation of sound mixing consoles; multi-track recording; use of effects processors; mixing; and mastering.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course the student will

- A. demonstrate advanced skills on Protocol,
- B. apply techniques learned on multiple mix down projects; and
- C. capture Foley audio for use in an audio project.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 2. mix down individual songs using standard DAW techniques and software. (B)
- 3. produce a group audio project. (A,B,C)
