Course Title: Studio Production

Course Prerequisites: COMM 290

Textbook: Owsinski, Bobby. *The Mixing Engineers Handbook*.

Course Description: This course covers music recording and mastering techniques needed to become an independent engineer and producer of contemporary commercial recordings. Students will be presented with an overview of multi-channel audio technology, software and effect plug-ins for film and music production. Current trends in multi-channel digital audio technology are examined.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course the student will

- A. select and place the proper microphone for a recording project;
- B. record and mix different audio sources; and
- C. comprehend the use of equalization, compression and effects to their mix.
