

## Bossier Parish Community College Master Syllabus

**Course Prefix and Number:** COMM 207 **Credit Hours:** 3

**Course Title:** Electronic Field Production

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Textbook:** None

**Course Description:** This course is designed to actively involve the students in mobile television production facilities and techniques. It includes opportunities to develop, direct, and produce live and recorded mobile video programming.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of this course the student will

- A. complete the set-up and connection of all necessary equipment for a field production;
- B. operate video and audio equipment in the field; and
- C. distinguish the differences between working in the field and in a controlled studio.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

(The letter designations at the end of each statement refer to the learning outcome(s).)

- 1. set-up and break-down a studio camera complete with headsets, cables, tripods, and dolly or spider pod. (A, B)
- 2. follow the director's cues to get camera shots and successfully produce 30-minute television program. (B)
- 3. connect microphones with audio snake, XLR cables and audio console, and monitor audio levels. (A, B)
- 4. set-up and break-down light kits.(A, B)
- 5. correctly put video/audio equipment back in proper storage facilities. (A, B)
- 6. operate switcher, CG, and other studio equipment. (B,C)
- 7. be able to set-up camera with cables and headsets in less than 15 minutes. (A, B)
- 8. compare the elements of working in the field and working in a studio. (C)

**Course Requirements:** This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
