- 2. block scenes; coach actors; and design basic light, properties, costumes, and sound plots. (A,B)
- 3. present a fully staged one act play that the student has directed. (A,B,C)
- 4. complete a director's prompt book recording all director research, planning and activities. (A,B,C)
