The series and related materials reinforce both traditional and emerging journalism styles in broadcast and public relations writing, and print journalism.

- B. apply the fundamentals of basic grammar, spelling, punctuation, and syntax; and
- C. write articles in a variety of journalism styles that include both hard news and feature stories.
