**Course Title:** Music Recital Lab

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Textbook(s):** None

**Course Description:** This course serves to enhance the music experience of students by offering live recitals, concerts, and lectures for a wide scope of music literature and musical topics.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of this course, the student will:

- A. Obtain an enhanced scope and appreciation for a wide variety of music;
- B. Receive valuable information on the business of music, concert etiquette, and other music specific topics; and
- C. Gain experience in performing, recording, or lecturing;

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will:

1. Attend recitals and concerts provided by the school, the community, and guest artists (A)
2. Attend lectures on various music topics by faculty, guest lecturers, or fellow students (B)
3. Perform and/or assist in recitals before their peers and instructors (C)

**Course Requirements:** This course requires attendance and participation. Students must attend or participate in pre-approved events to receive a passing grade of C (70% or higher).
