Course Title: Industrial Engineering Technology Field Experience

Course Prerequisite: Completion of 30 credit hours of TEED coursework with a grade of “C” or higher in each course.

Textbook(s): None

Course Description: Industrial Engineering Technology field experiences are practical work experiences related to various aspects of industrial engineering technology. Students are placed with pre-qualified companies that offer a broad range of field experiences to augment in class preparation. The field experience provides students with knowledge of what industrial technicians do, career opportunities, and how one can prepare to be a better technician. BPCC students will expand upon theory and concepts taught in industrial engineering technology courses and learn real-world problem-solving skills.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course, the student will:

- A. understand the nature of industrial engineering technology as applied in the workplace;
- B. demonstrate ability to organize and communicate technical and non-technical information orally; and
- C. prepare a resume, cover letter, and understand interview techniques.
