Course Title: Chamber Singers

Course Prerequisites: MUSC 148 – Concert Choir and Audition

Textbook(s): None

Course Description: An advanced choral ensemble of approximately sixteen voices specializing in the performance of chamber choral music from all historical periods. Open to all students by audition. On and off campus performances required as needed for public relations functions and semester concerts. (May be repeated for credit.)

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of this course, the student will

- A. perform appropriate advanced chamber choir repertoire in a variety of style periods with correct notes, rhythms, and expression;
- B. successfully sight-read appropriate chamber choir repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, and expression; and
- C. read and perform music at a higher level of proficiency than when they began the course.

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will

- 1. perform a variety of appropriate chamber choir repertoire with correct notes, rhythms, and expression through rehearsal and concert performance. (A)
- 2. develop their sight-reading skills using correct notes, rhythms, and expression through practice and performance application. (B)
- 3. develop their music reading and music performance skills to a higher degree of proficiency than when they began the course through distributed rehearsal, practice, and performance. (A,B,C)
- 4. recognize a variety of composers for the concert choir medium through rehearsal and performance. (A,B,C)

Course Requirements: This course requires attendance, class participation, assignments, exams, and projects as determined by the instructor.
