**Course Prefix and Number:** MUSC 230 **Credit Hours:** 2

**Course Title:** Applied Piano Lessons

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Textbook(s):** None

**Course Description:** A weekly private one-on-one lesson. Students will study proper performance techniques for their specific instrument or voice. Lessons may include, but are not limited to, traditional repertoire, scales, etudes, orchestral excerpts, solos, chamber music, sight reading, and other skills unique to the instrument or voice. A minimum of 14 lessons per term is required.

**Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of this course the student will

- A. The student will perform progressively challenging solo and study repertoire with proper stage presence and performance skills.
- B. The student will demonstrate proper musical technique appropriate to the voice or instrument.
- C. The student will sight-read appropriate repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, and expression.
- D. The student will read and perform music at a higher level of proficiency than when they began the course and course sequence (for subsequent semesters).

To achieve the learning outcomes, the student will:

- 1. perform characteristic and progressively challenging solo and study repertoire with proper stage presence and performance skills through demonstration, application, and distributed practice. (A)
- 2. successfully demonstrate proper musical technique appropriate to the voice or instrument. (B)
- 3. sight-read appropriate repertoire using correct notes, rhythms, and expression through demonstration, application, and distributed practice. (C)
- 4. read and perform music at a higher level of proficiency than when they began the course through demonstration, application, and distributed practice. (A,B,C,D)
